

## Here's what you do!

### 1. Choose your option

Group Rates: 2+ people \$10 off first time jumps. Can be various choices.

2. **Pick a date.** We train & jump on Saturdays or Sundays. 8 a.m. to sundown.

### 3. Call for reservation.

A \$50 non-refundable deposit per person is required by the Monday before your training date. Call in with your major credit card or make payment at the drop zone on Saturday or Sunday prior to your training date. Call first if you come during the week so we can meet you at drop zone.

### 4. And when the day comes....

Arrive at designated time. All equipment needed for your skydive is provided. Don't wear sandals; wear sports shoes; and dress for the weather. Bring your lunch, snacks and plenty of fluids. Spectators are welcome. Safety rules apply. Children must be supervised. Pets on leash ok. No alcohol drinking by anyone in our area during skydiving activities.

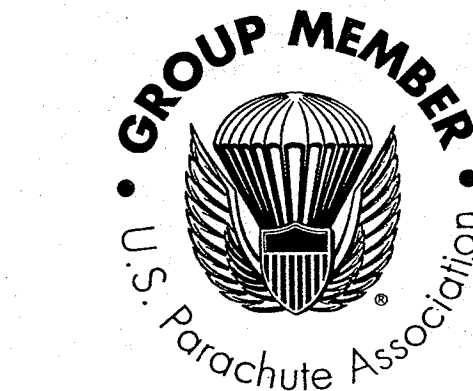
5. **Music video & pictures** of your skydive are available at a separate fee from ours. Only check or cash payment for video/photo package. Fee for package may range from \$75 - \$90.

# Your Skydive Options

## Option 1

### Tandem Skydive \$155.00

- ◆ Specific weekend appointments
- ◆ Max. weight limitation of 195 lbs.
- ◆ Video/pictures available at separate fee.
- ◆ One hour ground training - get the info & ask questions! Then skydive!
- ◆ Tandem is a dual-harness system; student is connected to certified tandem instructor.
- ◆ 10,000 feet skydive; nearly 40 seconds of free fall.
- ◆ Student assists with steering and landing the parachute.
- ◆ You are awarded with Certificate of Accomplishment.
- ◆ Plan approx. 2-3 hours of time.



MPC has been reputable drop zone and USPA approved Group Member Training Center since 1987. The training & safety guidelines established by the U. S. Parachute Association (USPA) and the Federal Aviation Admin. are followed.

## Option 2

### Accelerated Free Fall (AFF) \$275.00

- ◆ Level 1 - 8 am - late afternoon
  - ◆ Maximum weights 230 lbs.
  - ◆ Video/pictures available at separate fee.
- After a 7-hour ground training covering the basics of parachute safety & control and free fall, you'll make a free fall skydive from 10,000 feet supervised by two AFF-certified instructors. You'll do simple maneuvers during nearly 40-seconds free fall, pull the ripcord, and steer and land parachute back to the landing area. The instructors will debrief your dive objectives and offer guidance to prepare for the next level of skydive. Per the U. S. Parachute Association guidelines; continued training must be completed within 30 days of each jump level.

### Continued Training

**Performance must be achieved or repeat jump required at reduced fee.**

Block 1 Cost \$330 Includes ground instruction and **two** free fall skydives with two instructors teaching you basic moves of body flight, body and heading awareness, and hover control

Block 2 Cost \$281 Includes annual membership for USPA, ground instruction and **two** free fall skydives with two instructors teaching you basic turns, heading control, forward movement and docking, and spotting for the landing area.

Block 3 Cost \$230 Ground instruction and **two** free fall skydives introducing styles of exit, back loops, maneuvers in sequence, delta track and introduction to parachute packing.

Block 4 Cost \$180 Ground instruction and **two** skydives demonstrating all maneuvers. One jump will be the lower altitude "hop & pop", and continued packing lessons.

**Graduation to "Off Student Status." & on to USPA A-License!**

## Option 3

### Static-Line Jump \$240.00

- ◆ Class begins 8 am
- ◆ Maximum Weight 230 lbs.
- ◆ Static line deployed jump at 4,000 feet
- ◆ A "traditional" type experience from the old days...

You'll complete 5-hour ground training covering the basics of parachute safety & control. There is no free fall in this type of skydive. Your jump will be a static line deployed jump supervised by your instructor from the aircraft. After exiting the airplane properly, the static line pulls open the parachute open within 3-4 seconds. Then you'll steer and land the parachute back to the landing area. You will be awarded a Certificate of Accomplishment. Per United States Parachute Association guidelines, continued training must be completed within 30 days of this first jump level.

### Continued Training

Students will transition to the Accelerated Free Fall program. Cost for AFF Level I transition \$165.00

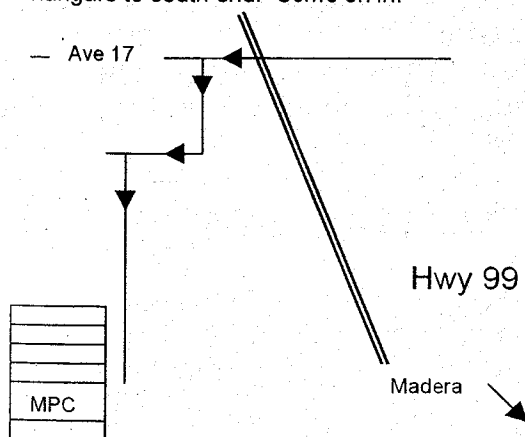
**Note: Prices for all training options may be subject to change without notice.**

### Important Information

- Minimum age is 18 years of age. No exceptions. Picture ID required.
- Any personal health or medical concerns should be discussed with your doctor to verify that no adverse affects would result from the vigorous sport of skydiving.
- The skydiving student is responsible for all aspects of training and jumping. This is an exciting sport in a new environment; the potential for injury or death does exist in this sport. An assumption of risk agreement and waiver of liability must be signed. Neither Madera Parachute Center nor Madera Municipal Airport does not provide any insurance of any kind to cover your injuries should any occur during skydiving ground training, aircraft ride, or actual jump. You are solely responsible.
- Madera Parachute Center staff reserves the right to refuse instruction or skydive completion to anyone who we determine unsafe to skydive.

Take Hwy. 99 to Madera then exit Ave 17 west off Hwy. 99 at Madera. Take first left onto Airport Drive. Go to 4-way stop and take a left onto Aviation Drive. Go to the 2nd to the last row of hangars to south end. Come on in!
